Reasons for comment:	
Comments:	I object to this planning application for several reasons. Firstly, brownfield sites need to be identified within the Gravesham Borough first and developed before agricultural land. Our village of Meopham and surrounding villages are very dependent on the A227 which has become very busy. When the road has emergency closures, traffic including large lorries are jammed in the lanes. Everything comes to a standstill. When temporary traffic lights are put up, the whole area becomes congested with school buses affected. Longfield Road has parked cars both sides, it is very difficult to drive through, having to give way to oncoming traffic. The pavement is narrow and not suitable for pedestrians due to speeding traffic. There could be 2 cars per household to add to our busy roads. The area lacks the infrastructure for more residents including public transport, health and dental services, schools, shops. The loss of green space and wildlife would diminish our rural setting. Our agricultural land plays an important role in food security and is fundamental to the character of the area. For these reasons, I object to this planning application.
