Comments:	<p>We are totally opposed to the proposed development. This is a completely inappropriate plan.</p> <p>Will lead to loss of irreplaceable agricultural land in a time of political, economic and climate instability.</p> <p>Will represent high risk of flooding. Developers will not address drainage issues in adjoining areas.</p> <p>Additional traffic will add to existing congestion and danger to residents.</p> <p>Meopham is a village with only village facilities and cannot support proposed increase in population - re doctors and school.</p> <p>Proposal will involve blocking A227 and endangering users of local lanes.</p> <p>Inappropriate location for people seeking affordable homes - due lack of facilities and reliance on cars to access Gravesend. Meopham station does not connect. Bus services are poor.</p> <p>Developments will destroy much valued wild life habitats and the rural character of Meopham which is the reason why people chose to live here.</p> <p>Proposals in the immediate vicinity would mean increasing population by more than 20 percent of The whole village.</p> <p>We believe it more appropriate to develop brown field sites in Gravesend thereby retaining the green belt for all to benefit from.</p> <p>We would ask what plans are on the council development plan for the Woodville / Civic Centre site ?</p> <p>Combination of current applications and another recently proposed development will mean the erosion of boundaries between Meopham and Sole Street in one urban sprawl, which the residents of both villages object to.</p>
