Comments:	<p>I am writing to formally object to this proposed planning application for a new housing development in Meopham.</p> <p>As a resident of 15 years, I am deeply concerned about the significant risks this project poses to the safety and wellbeing of our community. Meopham's infrastructure is already under severe strain-parking is insufficient, schools are over capacity, waste collection is inadequate, roads are congested, and local services are overstretched. The addition of hundreds of new homes will only intensify these challenges.</p> <p>The area near the MCA school is already prone to congestion and poses a safety risk. The transformation of our rural village into a densely populated area, exacerbated by increased through-traffic on the A227, threatens the character of Meopham and the quality of life for its residents.</p> <p>This development risks increasing overcrowding, crime, and traffic issues, while undermining property values and local businesses. The purported benefits do not outweigh the irreversible harm to our community.</p> <p>I urge decision-makers to reconsider and reject this application in the best interests of Meopham's current and future residents.</p>
