Comments:	1 This land is next to schools one of which is an SEN school. Traffic in this area is problematic, the road is restrictive with residents parking either side. Additional traffic would cause gridlock and be a danger to pupils, parents and pedestrians. 2 The land is agricultural land and contributes to food production. 3 The local area already struggles with GP access and availability for schools. In the wider context there is one A&E hospital already struggling to cope this will be an additional strain on the already overstretched GP, NHS and schools. 4 The current plan for Lower Thames Crossing will significantly increase traffic using the A227 which at times already becomes gridlocked when used as an alternate route. Additional traffic from additional housing would add to this problem. 5 Local infrastructure will be challenged 6 Impact of additional applications in the area should be considered overall when the above concerns become significantly increased
