Comments:	<p>[REDACTED] after much consideration and discussion amongst the neighbours have decided to wholeheartedly object to this development as it will impact us, and all our neighbours around the Willow Walk and Heron Hill area. This is not a rash or selfish decision but the effect on our community would be entirely detrimental for the below reasons.</p> <p>We have far too many cars and lorries already turning down Willow Walk just to turn round as it is a dead end road and when guardians/parents park the entire length of Willow Walk to drop off and pick up children at Culverstone Green Primary School this makes it impossible to venture out of our own homes during these busy times.</p> <p>There is no parking control along the A227 so cars park illegally and dangerously for much of the day.</p> <p>There is far too much traffic and pollution as it is, let alone with 100 more properties being considered.</p> <p>Turning in and out of the proposed access road will create a bottleneck. The A227 is a connecting main arterial road between the A2, A20, M20 and the M26. It is far too busy as it is let alone with the new proposal consideration.</p> <p>Public services are already under strain. The bus service along the A227 is inadequate with only one bus per hour.</p> <p>It is extremely difficult to get an appointment at the local doctors and dentist, we have even tried to join a different doctors in Borough Green which was denied on the grounds of being too far away.</p> <p>All the close shops and amenities are all overloaded as it is, parking at the local Culverston store (CO OP) is virtually impossible to park and as for the Meopham parade, it is even worse! This development will also impact on the local wildlife as there has been a noticeable decline in birdlife recently.</p> <p>Thank you for your time.</p>
