The natural habitats of thousands of animals, insects and birds will be forever destroyed and lost. The natural buffer for noise and air pollution will be lost to the detriment of our physical and mental health. Air and noise pollution will increase with the addition of at least 1-2 cars per home, even more. The fields are a natural sponge that soak away thousands of gallons of water each year but even with their help the roads are notorious for flooding. Green Lane is barely wide enough for 2 cars to pass in places and has no path or cycle lanes and a number of blind bends that make pulling out of Norward lane and the road coming from camera park a nightmare. Green Lane itself is used as a cut through for traffic using the A2/M2 and M20, the roads weren't built for the amount of traffic using them now, let alone adding hundreds more into the mix. Green Lane itself is gridlocked during school Lane, no matter what end of Norwood lane you come out of traffic is gridlocked with parents driving their children to schools which are already full and have waiting lists!... where do all the new children go to school, its not just Meopham school, instead rise, Cobham, culverstone and vigo are the same. Im sure schools in gravesend are full too. Access to further education is very limited as it is unless you can travel, yet more cars on the road. Parking for the primary school is extremely hazardous with many accidents, especially with people pulling out of the local parade. The new road layout has not helped and i've witnessed several accidents recently. As it is pathways are already obstructed by cars of local people who can't be bothered or don't have time to walk their children to school. New residents will be no different.

The local Drs have trouble coping with the amount of patients already on their books, waiting times for appointments will only get longer with more residents. The local hospital is woefully undersized and just can't cope with the amount of patients, it will get even worse with 2 huge developments being built close by. Patients are being sent further afield for treatment, regularly having to use London hospitals which has increased costs to patients.

We chose to live in a village because of everything it can offer, the way of life, the countryside, cleaner air and hopefully a safer environment to bring our children

up.

There are many sites in gravesend, the old derelict for many, many years, maternity hospital for one that should be redeveloped instead of being left to rot. Leave our village alone!!
