Chaos! The site is in a very inappropriate place for 350 new dwellings. This is a busy part of Meopham with a shopping parade and two schools close by. The parking has been insufficient for years and there is a massive amount of traffic in this area daily, especially at peak times. Congestion happens almost on a daily basis too whether caused by roadworks or accidents or school runs. The road is very difficult to cross and dangerous especially for the elderly and children. Green Belt Land! Would go against the NPPF policy which states Green belt land should only be used where there are exceptional circumstances and they are fully evidenced and justified. It's essential for the landscape, farming, wildlife and preventing urban sprawl. It helps alleviate the flash flooding that we are prone to and it's vital for it's contribution to residents wellbeing. Thames Crossing! This will greatly increase traffic on the A227 and surrounding villages. The Lower Thames Crossing Association in 2017 stated in a report that the A227 traffic is likely to DOUBLE through Meopham and surrounding villages. This will make traffic conditions more unbearable in the area. This is not the place for new dwellings!
