Comments:	<p>The infrastructure is not suitable for development. The A227 regularly floods, residents already clean the gullies and drains themselves to keep the road running. There will be significant loss of privacy, increased noise, pollution and disturbance for neighbouring properties. Increased traffic congestion, more safety hazards on main road, and lack of adequate parking will also impact the area. Insufficient school places, doctors and the main hospital already has patients on beds in corridors. The impact on wildlife will be catastrophic impacting on species that are already under threat and need our protection. The A227 simply cannot take any more traffic. There is not a week goes by when there are roadworks for damage caused to the highway by the existing levels of traffic. The Thames Crossing is likely to cause a rat run for HGV's which again will cause problems. Our green spaces are precious and need to be protected for mental health reasons and for generations to come. More focus should be given to development of brown belt sites like the old Gravesend Hospital. The council need to make brown belt the priority first and once exhausted then take stock of the housing needs.
