Comments:	<p>This application is sited adjacent to a SEN school where pupils are highly sensitive. The building, and existence, of houses adjacent to the school would undoubtedly cause stress and sensory overload to the pupils that attend this school.</p> <p>Furthermore, this is already a very narrow, congested road, where existing residents park their cars each side of the road, which further narrows the road. Adding an additional 120 houses which could potentially add 200+ cars to the area would further exacerbate congestion on this road, especially during school start and finish times.</p> <p>This land is also Greenbelt land which has not been released from the Greenbelt boundary.</p> <p>This development would increase the population of Meopham, putting a strain on the already overstretched GP and NHS Services, not to mention the very limited bus service and the commuter trains.</p>
