Comments:	I am objecting to this application for the following reasons: 1. Meopham is a small village that has some amazing areas of natural beauty and farm land that puts food on our tables. But it has a major A road running through it which is already an extremely busy road - the huge amount of large heavy vehicles and cars that use this road is already high. If this development goes ahead we will have in excess of 700 more vehicles plus delivery vehicles and service vehicles trying to use the A227 to access the new site. 2. The proposed site is a large farmland site fully used for food production. It is really important that as a country we are ensuring we can feed ourselves (using our farm land) rather than rely on importing food from other countries. In an unsettled time, we need to be able to feed our nation from within. 3. The A227 by the parade of shops is already an accident black spot. More vehicles using that stretch of road will only make that worse. We have a primary school and a pre-school close by and at busy times cars are parked along the A227 which causes chaos and will be made worse with more traffic using this road. 4. Dangerous access for new residents. 700+ cars and vans trying to access A227 near junction with Green Lane and busy parade of shops will cause accidents.
