Comments:	I wish to object to the proposed development of 350 homes on designated Green Belt land. This village has a long-established rural character which would be irreversibly harmed by a development of this scale and density. Local infrastructure and services - including schools, healthcare, and roads - are already oversubscribed and under significant pressure. There is no sustainable plan in place to address the additional demand this development would create. Furthermore, the site provides valuable natural habitats that support a range of wildlife, including a well-documented local owl population. The loss of these habitats would be detrimental to biodiversity and contradicts local and national commitments to nature recovery. For these reasons, I respectfully urge that this application be refused.
