Comments:	<p>My family and I have lived in Meopham for over 30 years and it's a beautiful place and continues to be so. With this plan you will not just wreck an area you will. Put pressure on our local roads is already unbelievable. The A227 is constantly used as a cut-through for HGVs and commuter traffic coming off the A2 and M20, and whenever the A227 is closed the surrounding rural lanes are completely gridlocked. Adding more development on top of what we already deal with will only make the congestion worse and raise serious safety concerns for everyone who lives here.</p> <p>We're also losing rural communities and farmland that have been part of this area for hundreds of years. Once this land is built on, it's gone for good. At a time when we should be protecting our ability to grow food and maintain national food security, watching productive farmland disappear is incredibly worrying. We need to be self-sufficient and not build on the green belt.</p> <p>On top of that, our infrastructure is already stretched well past its limits. Schools and medical centres are full, and parking, especially around Meopham Junior and Infant School. Already is a serious safety issue. Allowing more development without fixing these problems first is unsustainable and irresponsible. Remember your actions will be remembered for generations to come.</p>
