Comments:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>- this proposed development is on previously designated green belt and has been farmland ever since I moved to Meopham 37 years ago. Lose this source of food production and it is lost forever.</li><li>- there will be proposed access to this site is incredibly dangerous given Green Lane is a tiny rural lane.</li><li>- the additional traffic which will result from this development will cause gridlock at pinch points during the day: the morning and evening commute and school drop off and pick up times. We have seen numerous incidents in the last few years where, with a road closed or temporary lights, the whole village becomes gridlocked. These proposed extra houses will only exacerbate an already impossible situation.</li><li>- this development, and the other 2 or 3 developments planned in the vicinity are estimated to create an addition 1440 vehicles using the A227 as their main route into and out of Meopham. The current infrastructure simply cannot cope with this increase,</li><li>- the urban sprawl created by this and other developments in the area will result in the loss of the very fabric of this community. Meopham will no longer be a village and the character and charm of the village will be lost forever.</li></ul>
