Reasons for comment:	
Comments:	I object to this development. 120 residential dwellings would mean many more cars and delivery vehicles using the narrow Longfield Road and entering/ exiting at the access point. Longfield Road already has existing residents' vehicles parked along it and the additional volume of traffic going to and from 120 residential dwellings, if the proposed development were to go ahead (which could be double that number of cars or more, plus delivery vehicles) would make Longfield Road much more congested and dangerous.  Also, much of the additional traffic would use the A227. The junction of the A227 and Longfield Road would become even more dangerous if the proposed development were to go ahead, particularly at school pick up and drop off times. School children and parents and the general public (on foot and cyclists) who walk/ cycle, drop off children near the junction with the A227 and/ or need to cross the A227 / Longfield Road near the junction would be exposed to more danger due to the additional traffic there would be if the proposed development were to go ahead.
