Access on to Longfield Road from the proposed development would be dangerous (for a number of reasons including the narrowness the road, the proximity to existing houses and schools on Longfield road, existing residents park along the road and parents of school children park along the road at drop off and pick up time).</li><li>2. Traffic volumes would increase to unacceptable levels taking account of the size and layout of Longfield Road (including width, layout and sight lines, residential houses, schools and nearby shops).</li><li>3. The already hazardous A227/ Longfield Road junction would become more dangerous due to the additional volume of traffic from the new development (not only residents own vehicles but also delivery vehicles).</li></ol>
