Dear Sirs. I am appalled at the prospect of this application being successful. The area around the Helen Allison School is totally unsuitable for the potential significant increase in traffic. Longfield Rd, is a bottle neck at the moment where the schools start, and the housing estate opposite. Frequently in my car, where vehicles are parked in the road, I have to brake sharp, and pull over quickly to avoid a collision, this is made all the more dangerous when HGV's are coming towards you.

In addition, and of the utmost importance when we are trying to prevent air miles for food, and be less dependant on other countries for feeding our nation, to take this very valuable food growing land out of production, is fool hardy, and ludicrous, and I suggest is in the name of making a quick buck. What sense is there in removing high yield agricultural land out of production.
