Comments:	<p>I have submitted my objections to the other 2 proposed developments in Meopham and these are the same for this proposal.</p> <p>In short</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>1. The traffic is already a massive problem due to the A227 very frequently being blocked or very slow. It is a rat run when the A2 OR m20 are stopped or slow and there are frequent traffic flow problems due to leaks on the old roads and road structure issues and ice or snow on the Wrotham Hill</li><li>2. This is an important Green Belt area that creates a break between the urban areas nearer the river and the beautiful countryside. It is a carbon sump, a drain for flood waters preventing flooding, an area of ecological wonderland of ecosystems and wildlife.</li><li>3. The Infrastructure of Meopham is struggling already - the GP practice is very challenged by the numbers of patients, the two schools are at capacity and are on the A227 which contributes to the awful traffic in mornings and evenings, and the secondary schools at either end of the A227 are also at capacity.</li></ol> <p>No exceptional evidence has been presented for the need to build on such precious and protected land.</p>
