Comments:	<p>Please see list of objections.</p> <p>Brownfield sites should be exhausted before any other sites are developed.</p> <p>The location is 3+ miles from the closest station which is too far and will promote additional vehicle use.</p> <p>The density and garden size of the development is not in keeping with a rural location.</p> <p>The application itself confirms the likelihood that the site may be contaminated but lacks details on the what this may be and any planned resolution.</p> <p>The distance to many local amenities including secondary schooling and medical facilities exceed the agreed acceptable distances as published by chartered institute of highways. Its also worth noting that walking to Meopham Green for example requires walkers to cross the A227 on 5 occasions to remain on a foot path.</p> <p>The proposed development contains protected species.</p> <p>The proposed sustainable draining system is not adequate and presents a serious risk of flooding - given to topography of the site this presents a high risk of flooding the houses in the lower valley.</p> <p>The A227 is already a busy road and additional traffic is not acceptable and detrimental to local residents and wildlife through increased pollution.</p> <p>Local primary school is already at capacity which already causes significant parking challenges for parent dropping off and collecting pupils.</p>
