Comments:	<p>I'm against the application for the following reasons:</p> <p>It's important to preserve our greenbelt land. It acts as a carbon slum and helps alleviate flooding by providing natural run offs...there's a lot of flooding in heavy rain.</p> <p>We need to protect the natural environment of animals, birds and insects. We need to maintain our rural heritage and village distinctiveness.</p> <p>The infrastructure just can't cope already. Darent Valley Hospital can't cope with the amount of people living here already and many people are having to go into London hospitals for treatment. It's already next to impossible to get a Dr's appointment this situation will dramatically worsen. All local schools already have waiting lists.</p> <p>The traffic is already a major problem. Wrotham Road is at a virtual standstill during school run times and is increasingly used by heavy-duty vehicles and more cars as a cut-through from the A2/ M2 and M20. When the lower Thames crossing is opened this will increase dramatically. That brings us onto the increase in noise pollution and bad air quality!! Pulling out of the parade is notoriously dangerous with several accidents caused in the last few months, crossing Wrotham Road is increasingly dangerous, it's only a matter of time before someone is killed. Hundreds of extra cars will only add to the danger as each house will probably come with at least 2 cars if not more. All the extra traffic sitting outside the primary school and Hellen Alison School is not healthy for the children and with hundreds of extra cars added to the mix all road and pollution issues will just get worse. All of the above will be significantly worse.</p>
