Comments:	<p>I object to this planning application for 150 houses. It would encourage urban sprawl. It would be a strain on the overstretched GPs which are already at capacity. One hospital for all the overdevelopments which already cannot cope. Cause damage to the environment. Wrotham Road and Norwood Lane already floods and concreting over fields will only increase this as rainwater cannot be absorbed and there is insufficient drainage. Dangerous access for high volumes of traffic onto small country lane. High volumes of traffic accessing onto A227 which is used as cut through from M20 and A2 by cars and HGVs.
