Comments:	I object to the proposal for the following reasons: Meopham and surrounding areas do not have the infrastructure to cope with additional housing - public services are already at their limits with log waits for doctors surgeries/hospital appointments and no school places. The road infrastructure cannot cope with the current volume of traffic, given that this will be increased (anticipated by 50%) by the Lower Thames Crossing the villages will be at gridlock. add to this the potential pollution issues.
