Comments: The current infrastructure will not support the proposed new homes. I already struggle to get a GP appointment. 3 local schools will be impacted. Wrotham road is constantly dug up and worked on as it is. If this went ahead it would be severely detrimental to our village life here in Meopham and it would certainly lose that village feeling. When the A2 has a problem (which is often) traffic often comes through Meopham and the area just cant take anymore volume. Meopham Secondary has already expanded and have had to make use of temporary building to deal with the amount of students and these homes will only add more when they are clearly at capacity already!. The same goes for the primary school!
The GP surgery won't be able to cope either. We have tried to get an appointment [REDACTED] on more than one occasion and have been told to take him to the walk in centre in Gravesend, when we literally live over the road fom the surgery, a 2 min walk!! Its ludicrous and these extra homes will only make all these problems worse.
