Comments:	<p>Completely against due Destruction of valued and essential green belt land, an asset to Gravesham and the country. Loss of farm land Traffic congestion and danger due introduction new junctions and envisaged high number additional cars in vicinity of schools and local shops. Expect A228 to be gridlocked especially at peak times and with construction of new lower Thames crossing Believe consultation application process is not valid given that it does not take into account all those affected -ie whole village and surrounding communities. Plans do not reflect local needs and need for social housing misplaced - should focus on towns with possible employment, social facilities and adequate public transport (not present in Meopham) Noise, air and light pollution. Will destroy present community with some villagers choosing to move and others faced with division of the village due to difficulty accessing or crossing A227 in future.
