Comments:	<p>I object to this proposal in full, due to:</p> <p>Destruction of much valued green belt.</p> <p>Additional traffic on already congested village roads and lanes.</p> <p>As a local parent I am particularly concerned by the danger posed by traffic, which seems to be promoted by local government rather than addressed (eg development of shops and restaurants on Camer Parade with no safe or legal parking)</p> <p>Loss of beautiful rural environment which is appreciated by local residents - an amenity for walkers, dog walkers, runners - not just locals for whom this will be lost forever.</p> <p>Special concern re disruption for SEN school.</p> <p>Local facilities cannot sustain increased population proposed.</p> <p>Runoff of additional building will add to risk of flooding which has not been addressed locally by council / highways</p> <p>Loss of farmland which should be avoided at all costs given present international political instability and climate uncertainty.</p> <p>Insufficient local public transport.</p> <p>Meopham railway station is not relevant given reduced services, no link to Gravesend and old ideas re commuting (flexible working) generally do not apply.</p> <p>Local doctors surgery and schools do not have capacity to accommodate increased village population proposed.</p>
