Comments:	I have lived in Meopham for over 28 years and find myself objecting to the fourth proposed housing development in just a matter of a few months. The traffic on the A.227 is already too heavy and unsuitable for even more vehicles. Container lorries . cut through from the A.20 to the A.2. The road is too narrow and will be subjected to even more traffic with the proposed new tunnel under the Thames. As residents, we have to contend with the fumes and dirt that this traffic causes plus, of course, the noise. The A.227 is not built to take this heavy traffic and every year, without fail, potholes appear to the detriment of residents. Meopham is a village. However, if these developments go ahead, it will become a town. Our education and health facilities are already overstretched and will not be able to accommodate more pupils and patients. Our green fields, which should be used for agricultural purposes, will disappear again to the detriment of the local community. We already have a resident in Norwood Lane, who is seriously considering developing her land into another housing estate. These developments are so unacceptable for the current residents who will be the ones that suffer enormously if these proposals go ahead

Green Lane & Norwood Lane are already cut throughs to Cobham and the A.2. Another housing development will automatically add to this traffic and another access road in Green Lane could be very dangerous.

I sincerely hope that the application will be considered sympathetically, taking the interests of Meopham residents into consideration. Please let us retain what little we have left of green belt.
