Comments:	<p>I object to this proposal on the following grounds:</p> <p>This development undermines the purpose of designated "green belt" areas which are designed to prevent the desecration of our villages and prevent urban sprawl.</p> <p>The green belt classification is also important to ensure that villages do not merge and become towns. This designation was designed to protect our countryside and wildlife. The proposal(s) will create additional pollution in the way of light, air and noise and this (and other proposed developments) would harm the biodiversity and the important habitats that the countryside provides with trees and hedgerow.</p> <p>Add into this the lack of infrastructure for this (and other developments) in the form of doctors, dentists/hospital appointments and school places and the impact on our roads- which are already very busy - and the anticipated 50% increase in traffic with the completion of the Lower Thames crossing and this proposal is not viable</p> <p>Our greenbelt must be protected and more appropriate sites sourced - brownfield sites and vacant housing. These proposals are creating inappropriate encroachment on our countryside.</p>
