Comments:	<p>- [] N</p> <p>I object to this application as this is still green belt land and quality farmland on the edge of our village. This land needs to be preserved for farming food production and the habitat of wildlife.</p> <p>Green Lane is very narrow along the section where the developers propose access to this land & would be hazardous to other traffic and road users.</p> <p>Green Lane & Norwood Lane are already used as cut throughs at peak times. Norwood Lane is also a single track lane & totally unsuitable to traffic travelling in both directions.</p> <p>The adjacent conservation area would be impacted, both visually and physically, with wildlife & the natural habitat affected.</p> <p>Another 150 houses with 300 + vehicles adding to congestion to schools, GP surgery & local shops etc in the area.</p> <p>The Lower Thames crossing will already increase traffic congestion through Meopham in the future & the A227 and Green Lane would create traffic chaos for vehicles entering & exiting the proposed development.</p> <p>With other proposals in north Meopham, this potentially would increase the village population by one third or more.</p> <p>More proposed developments on Norwood Lane if accepted would link Meopham to Sole Street, creating one town not two villages.</p>
