Comments:	<p>I Strongly Object to these planning applications as Meopham is a only a small village. The proposal to build these and other planning applications within such close proximity will overwhelm the area.</p> <p>We have minimal facilities including one medical centre, and with no dental practice locally.</p> <p>The nearest train station has only two trains an hour and one on a Sunday, with a poor bus service, one bus an hour during the week.</p> <p>There is also very poor street lighting and CCTV because we have a low crime rate. Extra street lighting and CCTV will need to be installed at immense cost, increasing the Council Tax bill to our surrounding community.</p> <p>Housing developments need areas that can sustain them with infrastructure and services .</p> <p>However within the last few months we already have as many planing proposals for the same area.</p>
