Reasons for comment:

Comments:	I drive along the A227 from Gravesend to Conifer drive many times a week and the road is extremely busy most of the time. Many HGV vehicles use this road as do farming vehicles which results when they meet that traffic slows down to a few mph whilst they pass each other. The road is frequently damaged due to its high usage and results in temporary traffic lights being put in place for a few days whilst they are repaired. It can often take me over 20mins to get from the A2 to Culverstone.  When it rains heavily (which it often does) then the section of road where the houses are proposed floods badly, often going from one side of the road to the other.  Parking is a nightmare near the few local shops which means that you find cars parked on the pavement outside Costcutters or parked on yellow lines outside any of the shops, especially those at Camer Parade, even though the road has recently had a middle section installed and posts installed in the ground. Cars & lorries still park up, even on the double lines as do delivery vehicles delivering to the shops.
