Reasons for comment:	
Comments:	Constructing 120 houses on agricultural fields within the Green Belt will permanently destroy an area of natural beauty that should be preserved for this and future generations. These fields form an essential part of the rural landscape, providing open views, wildlife habitat, and a sense of separation between communities-benefits that cannot be replaced once lost.
	Beyond the environmental harm, the proposed development would generate a significant increase in traffic on roads that are already operating at full capacity. Local infrastructure cannot safely absorb the additional vehicle movements associated with 120 new homes. This raises a serious health and safety concern, particularly for the SEN school located directly adjacent to the site, where increased traffic flow and congestion would heighten risks for vulnerable children, staff, and families accessing the school daily.
	This development would place unnecessary strain on the local area, compromise safety, and result in the irreversible loss of protected countryside. For these reasons, we strongly object to the proposal.
