Comments:	<p>I have lived in the local area with my family for nearly 9 years and have a child who attends Istead Rise Primary School.</p> <p>I strongly object to this development going ahead for the following reasons:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none">1) More loss of greenbelt land and enjoyable green space resulting in the destruction of wildlife, taking away the beautiful views enjoyed by so many who live here, taking away what feels like a little village, and turning it into another town.2) The infrastructure in the area is already stretched already cannot cope. Extra pressure will be inflicted on an already struggling/at breaking point NHS service at the GP surgery and local hospital (Darent Valley).3) The extra traffic that this development will inevitably create around the area (154 new dwellings with families potentially owning multiple vehicles), not only impacts the air pollution and noise pollution but also the safety of our roads, especially around the school, creating a very dangerous environment for our children.4) There is also the increased risk of flooding along Downs Road, with this risk increased with the removal of yet more vitally important farm land.

In short, a development of this size will have a huge negative impact on existing residents and wildlife of Istead Rise and the surrounding areas.
