Comments:	1 . 100 houses - at least 150 vans and cars plus delivery traffic daily. 2 The A227 is just capable of 2 way traffic - often jammed up by deliveries and breakdowns. It is at its limit. [REDACTED] More houses more early morning traffic - more jams. More thundering, diesel fuming, stationary HGVs. 3 Meopham is at the moment just about deserving of the title "village". I do not want to see that status destroyed. The Meadfield development completed a sustainable community. 4 A grant of this scale would only be used by other developers as a precedent for the grabbing of more agricultural land. By this salami slicing Meopham would lose its character as a different and rurally attractive environment for countryside activities, especially useful for short rural exploits to those new inhabitants of the thousands of houses already built and further planned between the Thames and the M2. - That is a sensible use of ex industrial land. Meopham is country land not ex industrial. We do not want another Thamesmead in this area. 5 Our Medical, educational, small and diverse retail facilities suit this rural community without overburdening it. They are of 'rural' dimensions. We do not want to change our character by encouraging the 'Aldis' and Lidl's and crush local entrepreneurs.
