Comments:	I strongly object to the building of houses on this piece of land. The road network surrounding the land is completely overwhelmed already, let alone with the new tunnel that is being built where additional pressure is being allowed on meopham. The doctors surgery is already at capacity. There are no nhs dentists locally with availability as it is. I urge the case officer to visit the site at school times and see the reality of the situation, especially when it is wet or cold. The roads are gridlocked. The pavements are barely able to take the amount of pedestrians let alone with additional footfall and traffic. The impact to the local schools of the building work should also not be underestimated. The merging of Longfield and meopham is also not wanted by either village, as is the amount of distraction to the greenbelt. It feels as is gravesham council have their hearts set on destroying meopham and the residents have very little option. Its heartbreaking.
