Comments:	<p>I strongly object to this proposal. The merging of villages is an absolute travesty. The area is not equipped for additional houses- the local amenities are already at breaking point. The roads, especially at school times, are gridlocked. The pavements are unable to take the amount of footfall as it is. I walk the 0.7 miles to MCA every morning and most days beat the traffic. Let alone the fact that Wrotham road has already been accepted as having a high impact when the new tunnel is open. How much destruction do gravesham council expect meopham residents to accept in air quality, quality of life and noise pollution. We pay a premium to live in this area but our way of life is being destroyed. How many children have to die on Wrotham Road before gravesham council accept that ploughing more cars, lorries and vans through a country road next to a school is unacceptable. I urge the case officer to please see this application as nothing more than unnecessary destruction of greenbelt land and money grabbing and decline this application. It is not wanted and there are plenty of other more acceptable places to build, not somewhere which will impact the community in such a way.</p>
