Comments:	Meopham Road A227 is already congested and at times dangerous so a further 350 properties and potentially 700 vehicles plus delivery vehicles will only increase the accident risk. The Parade and junction with the Longfield Road and Camer Road are already accident black spots and regularly congested throughout the day. This is prime farm land used for food production which should continue to avoid increased expensive imports as well as increasing large delivery vehicles. The local primary school and SEN school are nearby as are 2 children play areas. This additional housing , population and traffic volumes totally ignore the safety and welfare of children and families. Meopham is a village and services are already overstretched in the local vicinity ,area and district. This development should not be progressed.
