Comments:	Completely absurd plans for access to 350+ house site directly on the A227 opposite the parade of shops.  This is an extreemly busy road with cars often in the middle of the road turning right out of the shops. If a house estate is built i am sure there will be even more frequent accidents at this junction. The parade of shops is already a black spot for cars pulling out.  A227 queues from Meopham Station all the way up to the secondary school every day. Another 700 cars + delivery and service vehicles joining the road here will cause absolute chaos with 2 major junctions with Longfield Road and Green Lane also joining the A227 in the same place along with a very busy primary school.  The area of road near the George pub is too small for two HGVs to pass at the same time, causing delays.  This is ruining the greenbelt land and will effect food production in the area.  The A227 often floods, building on this land will make the problem even worse.  There are plenty of brownfield sites which are left deralict in the Gravesham borough which should be considered instead of land adjacent to a Conservation

Area.
