Comments:	<p>Completely absurd plans for access to 350+ house site directly on the A227 opposite the parade of shops.</p> <p>This is an extreemly busy road with cars often in the middle of the road turning right out of the shops. If a house estate is built i am sure there will be even more frequent accidents at this junction. The parade of shops is already a black spot for cars pulling out.</p> <p>A227 queues from Meopham Station all the way up to the secondary school every day. Another 700 cars + delivery and service vehicles joining the road here will cause abolute chaos with 2 major junctions with Longfield Road and Green Lane also joining the A227 in the same place along with a very busy primary school.</p> <p>The area of road near the George pub is too small for two HGVs to pass at the same time, causing delays.</p> <p>This is ruining the greenbelt land and will effect food production in the area.</p> <p>The A227 often floods, building on this land will make the problem even worse.</p> <p>There are plenty of brownfield sites which are left derelict in the Gravesham borough which should be considered instead of land adjacent to a Conservation</p>
