I object to this planning application as I believe this land to be green belt land which is good quality farmland and will contribute to food production which should be encouraged, promoted and preserved in this area.2. This proposal would create a dangerous access to 350 houses off the A227 near a junction with Longfield Road, a busy parade of shops, Green Lane and a busy school at peak times.3. This proposal would create more traffic on nearby lanes ie. Norwood Lane, Huntingfield Road, Tradescant Road, Camer Park Road and Foxendown Lane, these would all be impacted and become ratruns for drivers avoiding the area.4. Adjacent conservation area and wildlife around Camer park would be impacted, much wildlife including owls, woodpeckers, bats, badgers and foxes can often be spotted or heard in the area and should be protected from development.5. I believe the increase in traffic using the A227 and Green Lane, because of the lower Thames Crossing, would have a huge impact in this area of the village.
