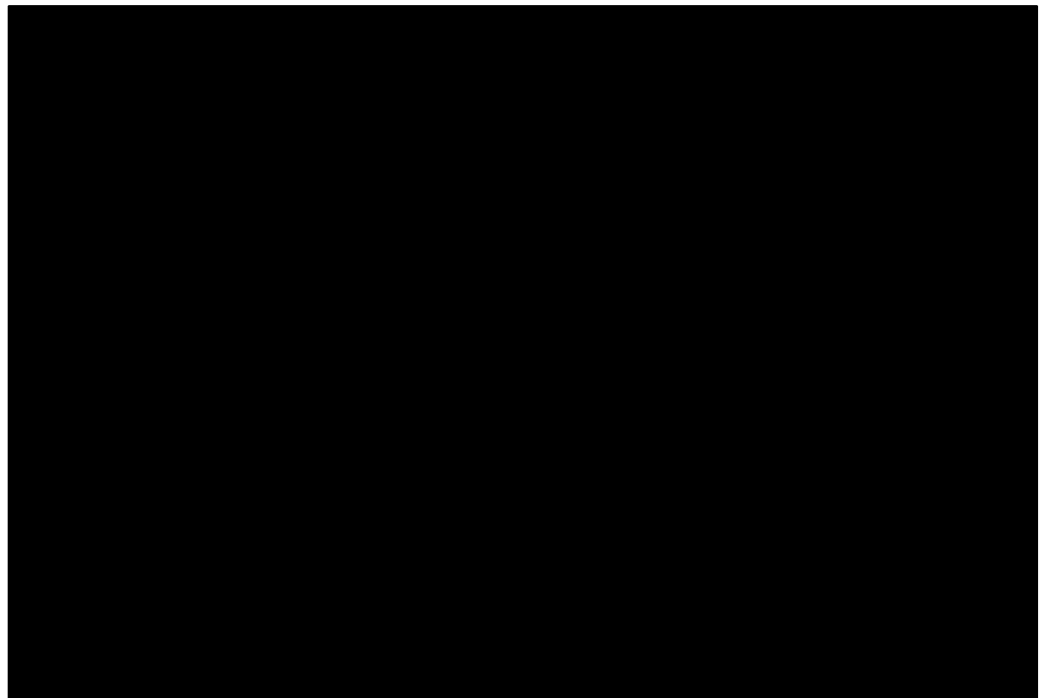

Meopham will lose its open character and unique historic features

The loss of Agricultural Land is not good sustainable practice; we need food security.

Our local infrastructure is struggling, not just the obvious ones like Hospitals and GP's, but Secondary Schools and FE provision. Our GP surgery is struggling now with the volume of patients and ICB cutting funds to local home visiting service will put more strain on the surgery. The hospitals will not cope with their funding being cut, no recruitment for newly qualified nurses how will patients get better care now it's going to be impossible with more people moving to the village and same with secondary schools, how can you add more children to the school when already full.

Increases in traffic will impact on vulnerable students at Helen Allison School and Meopham Primary School. It had already taken [REDACTED] over an hour to get to Helen Allison this week because of traffic which is normally a 10min journey. Due

The A227 is at capacity, as I have said traffic is very busy with 3 schools in the village. When A2 is busy a lot more traffic comes through the village
