Comments:	<p>I feel I must object to this development on green belt land. There are many derelict brown field sites around the canal basin that are ideal for redevelopment. Some of these areas have views of the Thames or canal and would make very desirable homes whilst improving a neglected and under-used area.</p> <p>The proposed location would add to the already congested roads around Culverstone School, especially at school times when the area is already littered with "parked" cars. It would impose further strain on Meopham surgery, where it is almost impossible to make a GP appointment and add further to the chaos of vehicles surrounding the entrance to the surgery and Meopham School. It would also doubtless increase the almost continual single way working, due to road works, on Wrotham Road, during the construction of the development.</p> <p>We are all encouraged to leave open land undisturbed to assist with drainage due to the very heavy rain we now endure, due to climate change. This development would remove a further 20 acres of this valuable resource forever, which will no doubt add to the flooding of the A227 along Wrotham Road, of which I am sure you are aware.</p> <p>Housing, especially affordable housing is certainly required but I beg you to refuse permission for this mis-placed development, which further erodes the rapidly diminishing green spaces and clean air all of us value.</p>
